

This Privacy Policy applies to the business practices of Anesthesia Consultants of Dallas, L.L.P., including its web site located at www.acdllp.com, and to the business practices of Veritas Anesthesia, L.L.P., including its web sites located at www.veritasanesthesia.net and www.anesthesiadallas.com and all associated sites linked to www.acdllp.com, www.veritasanesthesia.net and www.anesthesiadallas.com, including, but not limited to any mobile versions of these web sites, as applicable, (collectively, the “Site”). Anesthesia Consultants of Dallas, L.L.P. and Veritas Anesthesia, L.L.P. are collectively referred to as “Company”, “we”, “our” or “us” in the remainder of this document. The Site is the property of the Company.

Your privacy is important to the Company. We have developed this Privacy Policy to delineate how we collect, use and disclose your information. Collection and Use of Personal Information:

Personal information (“PI”) is information that can be used to uniquely identify an individual.

We may ask you to provide your PI in order for us to better serve your needs. The Company, and its affiliates, may share this personal information with each other and use it consistent with this Privacy Policy.

What PI We May Collect:

- Name
- Demographic information
- Health information
- Mailing address
- Phone number
- Email address
- Contact preferences
- Social Security number (SSN)
- Insurance information
- Credit card information

How We Use Your PI:

- Providing you with a bill for our services

- Working with your insurance company to assist you in paying for our services
- Obtaining payment for our services
- Obtaining information from you regarding your satisfaction with our services
- To send you important information
- Internal auditing, data analysis and research to improve our services and business
- To secure your personal mobile devices in order to ensure the Company's compliance with HIPAA policies
- To supply paging services and communication amongst members and employees of the Company.

Collection and Use of Non-Personal Information:

We also collect non-personal information ("NPI") – information that does not permit direct association with any specific individual. Aggregate and de-identified data regarding Site users is also considered non-personal information. We use "cookie" technology and similar technology to gather non-personal information from our Site visitors such as which pages are used and how often they are used, and to enable certain features on our Site. Because NPI does not identify who you are, we do not limit the ways we may use or share non-personal information.

What NPI We May Collect:

How We Use Your NPI:

- Internal auditing, data analysis and research to improve our patient care processes which will improve our quality of care
- Internal auditing, data analysis and research to improve our patient relations systems which will improve our patient satisfaction
- Internal auditing, data analysis and research to improve our services and business

**If we combine NPI with PI the combined information will be treated as PI.

Message Boards:

We also may offer message boards, bulletin boards, chat rooms, comments areas or other forums on our Site for use by visitors to our Site. Any information you disclose when posting a message in these forums may become public. You should not include any information in your posting that you do not want other parties to see or use. Moreover, if you post any messages in the Message Board that includes

your e-mail address or phone number you may receive unsolicited e-mails or calls from third parties.

Company's Commitment to Your Privacy:

To make sure your PI is secure, we communicate our Privacy Policy and security guidelines to Company employees and strictly enforce privacy safeguards within the company.

Protection of PI:

We take precautions (administrative, technical, and physical measures) to protect your PI against loss, theft, misuse or unauthorized access.

Integrity and Retention of PI:

We will retain your PI for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy unless a longer retention period is required by law.

Disclosure to Third Parties:

At times we may make certain PI and NPI available to our third-party vendors who assist us in providing our services and conducting our business. Your PI is protected by agreements between Company and our third-party vendors and by their privacy practices. Your PI will only be provided to our third party vendors for specific purposes that enable us to conduct or improve our services and business; it will not be shared with third parties for the benefit of these third parties outside of their relationship with Company.

It may be necessary because of legal requirements or requests from governmental agencies for Company to disclose your PI. Partnership will use its best efforts to protect your PI, as much as is possible, in these situations.

In the event of a merger, or sale of our business, we may need to transfer the relevant PI and NPI that we collect to the surviving entity or the acquiring party. .

Finally, the Site may contain links to third party websites. Information collected by these third parties is governed by their own separate and independent privacy policies. Therefore, we have no responsibility or liability for the content and activities of these linked sites. Nevertheless, we strive to protect the integrity of our Site. We encourage you to learn about the privacy policies of those third parties and welcome any feedback about these sites.

Access to PI:

We will make a good faith effort to provide you with access to your PI to enable us to correct the data if it is inaccurate. We may decline your request to review your PI if the request is unreasonable, impractical, requires an unreasonable amount of Company resources, jeopardizes the privacy of others, or for which access is not

permitted or required by local law.
